# PEDIATRIC ASTHMA FORUM 2010

The 2010 Pediatric Asthma Forum, presented by Children's Hospital & Research Center Oakland, in partnership with the Regional Asthma Management & Prevention (RAMP) Initiative, will take place on Saturday, April 17, 2010 at Children's Hospital Oakland's Outpatient Center.

This day-long event will focus on spirometry and allergy testing in the primary care setting. Learning sessions will be a combination of Powerpoint presentations, interactive learning sessions and exhibits.

## OBJECTIVES

Participants will be able to:

- Explain why spirometry is an important tool in the management of pediatric asthma
- Describe how to perform spirometry in the clinical setting and understand basic spirometry interpretation
- Use communication techniques to empower patients and families in the successful management of asthma
- Explain why allergy testing is an important tool in the management of pediatric asthma
- Describe how to perform allergy skin testing in the clinical setting and when to use Rast/Immunocap testing.

### MORNING SESSION

Spirometry experts **Jim Stout, MD, MPH** and **Karen Smith, MD**, from the University of Washington will be providing an interactive spirometry training session for attendees. They will also provide research-based clinical applications for the primary care setting.

### WORKING LUNCH

**Michael Cabana, MD, MPH**, of UCSF and the former director of the Physician Asthma Care Education (PACE) program, will be lecturing during lunch on communication techniques that empower patients and families.

### AFTERNOON SESSION

Allergy expert **Guillermo R. Mendoza, MD**, from Kaiser Permanente in Vacaville will be discussing allergy testing as an important tool in the management of pediatric asthma.
